

INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING BY AB S.A.

1. The personal data provided by the Customer is controlled by AB S.A. with its registered office in Magnice (55-040), ul. Europejska 4 (hereinafter the Controller). The Controller receives Customers' personal data from the entity with which the Customer placed an order or from the manufacturer/supplier of the services ordered by the Customer.
2. The personal data is processed by the Controller in line with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: GDPR) and other applicable regulations.
3. The data disclosed by the Customer at order placement is processed by the Controller pursuant to Art. 6.1.b of GDPR, in order for the Controller to conclude and perform the contract with the entity with which the Customer placed its order.
4. Apart from the purpose specified above, personal data may be processed by the Controller also to perform the Controller's legal obligations (Art. 6.1.c of GDPR), in particular its accounting and tax obligations, as well as in on the basis of the Controller's legitimate business interests, in order to protect the Controller's rights, including in particular lodging of claims (Art. 6.1.f of GDPR).
5. Personal data is processed by the Controller solely or the time requires to accomplish the purpose of processing or completion by the Controller with its legal obligations and if the time limit for claims that may arise from such purposes is longer - maximum until such time expires.
6. The personal data may be disclosed to entities cooperating with the Controller in the sphere of providing electronic services and concluding and performing contracts, in particular manufacturers/suppliers of ordered services, product suppliers, entities involved in complaint handling entities providing accounting, consulting, maintenance services as well as IT services to the Controller. Personal data may be transferred outside the EEA by the Controller. Such transfer may solely occur to countries covered with a decision of the European Commission on adequate personal data protection; in case of other countries – solely to entities that assure appropriate protection of the data, in particular in the form of standard contractual clauses or on the basis of Art. 49.1.c of GDPR if such transfer it required to provide the Customer with preferential purchase terms, guaranteed by the manufacturer or to activate and handle the acquired software licences.
7. Subject to the regulations on personal data protection, Customers are entitled to access their disclosed data, have it corrected, processing restricted, data portability, to request to have it deleted as well as the right to file a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Authority.
8. When the processing is carried out on the basis of lawful interests of the Controller (Art. 6.1.f of GDPR), the Customer shall be entitled to (subject to the exceptions provided for in applicable laws) to file an objection to process the personal data if justified with the Customer's specific circumstances.
